SUBJECT: Collective Bargaining Agreement with Fraternal Order of Police:  
General Wage Adjustment

On April 29 the Council approved a resolution concerning the collective bargaining agreement with the Fraternal Order of Police. The resolution is on ©1-2. The fiscal impact statement is on ©3-4.

As indicated on ©2, the Council expressed its intent to appropriate the funds and approve the changes in law or regulations necessary to implement the agreement. The Council also reserved its right to reduce, defer, or otherwise decline to fully fund the general wage adjustment.

In the memo on ©5-6, Council President Subin expresses the view that in this extremely difficult budget year this general wage adjustment is sustainable and that the Council should commit to funding it.

**Committee Recommendation:** The Council will not exercise the right it reserved to itself on April 29 with regard to the general wage adjustment in the collective bargaining agreement with the Fraternal Order of Police and agrees to fund it.
