Despite what the March 8 article said, Montgomery County police officers are responding to speed citations in accordance with Maryland law.

It is the police chief who is holding himself above the law. Maryland law says that the owner of a vehicle who gets a speed camera citation but was not driving at the time of the violation has to identify the driver. The ticket is then reissued to the driver.

The police chief is not following that process; instead he is just passing the ticket on to the officer. This deprives officers of the rights all other residents have: to request a hearing and contest the ticket, or to pay the fine.
